

## Funlab-disks-intro

This is an example.....there other commands available for the same functionality.

Some introduction to commands:

1. List your disks

```
lsblk
```

2. List filesystems on disks

```
lsblk -f
```

3. List mounted filesystems

```
df -h
```

4. Partition a disk

```
fdisk
```

5. Create a filesystem on a disk

```
mkfs
```

6. Create a mountpoint

```
mkdir
```

7. Mount a filesystem to a mountpoint

```
mount
```

8. Add the new filesystem to the file /etc/fstab to automatically mount at boottime.
