In this lab you will use a free disk to mount and setup up an NFS share. The file system will have the sticky bit set.

Clients (your collegeages) will be able to access the share from their system and can create files and will be able to delete only their own files.

- 1. Use your available disk (so NOT bootdisk) to create a new ext filesystem and mount it to /mnt/share.
- 2. Export /mnt/share for the world and also allow root users from other systems to write to the filesystem.
- 3. Ask some of your colleagues to create a local mount point on their system and mount your share to their mountpoint.
- 4. Make sure that the users that use your share cannot delete each other's files.
